- Responsible for the correct encoding of the farmer's data (by giving some support to the farmer and conducting some virtual interviews with the farmer to finalise data collection)
- Review of the encoded data, generation and review of the mySoilCapital diagnostic
- Delivery of the mySoilCapital report to farmers, accompanied by a management plan to structure the farmer's intentions to respond to the report's findings
- Participation in the development of the mySoilCapital tool by collecting feedback from farmers and communicating it internally
- Strengthening relationships with existing clients by becoming the privileged contact with farmers from the moment a mySoilCapital diagnostic has been ordered to its delivery and beyond
